Sugar is the ingredient that gives food a sweet taste. Nature gives some fruits, sugar as they grow. Peaches, grapes and oranges are some fruits that are naturally sweet.

Most foods have no sugar of their own. It must be added, or the food may be tasteless : Candies, cakes and pies must be sweetened with sugar. Sugar is often added to medicine.

Most of the sugar comes from a plant called cane. Sugarcane grows in stalks, like grass. A single stalk runs along the ground for 20 feet, then shoots straight up in the air for four more feet. These stalks make sugar cane fields very tangled and dense.

To harvest cane sugar, workers first burn the fields. This gets rid of the leaves and dried stalks, but it doesn't hurt the cane at all. The cane is then cut by hand or machine, washed, crushed and boiled. It is a long and difficult process to make white sugar.

The Indians knew how to get sugar from maple trees. They drilled, put tubes inside and placed pails underneath the trees. This method is still used in the eastern United States.
